TERMINATOR is a powerful broad spectrum bactericide, disinfectant solution designed specifically with businesses in mind that are looking to stay safe and compliant for both customers and staff safety. TERMINATOR cleans and sanitises all surfaces which are likely to cause cross contamination, such as light switches, door handles, computer keypads, work surfaces, etc.

TERMINATOR meets with EN1276 & EN14476.

BS EN 1276 is the European standard for the bactericidal activity of chemical disinfectants as proof of effective infection control against harmful micro-organisms such as MRSA, Salmonella, E.Coli, Flu Virus (H1N1) and Pseudomonas Aeruginosa. To meet with this standard, products must prove a bacteria kill rate of 99.999% within 5 minutes. EN14476 is the European standard similar to EN1276, but specifically to be effective against viruses.

TERMINATOR COMES IN TWO DIFFERENT AEROSOL FORMS. The standard 400ml aerosol will allow the operator to spray the bactericide directly onto specific areas light switches, door handles, computer keypads, work surfaces, etc.

The 200ml "bomb" should be activated and left in the area to be treated. This aerosol has a "lock" on the nozzle so the operator can set up the operation and walk away, returning 5 minutes later to find the area sanitised. The product kills viruses on contact. Recommended areas for "the Bomb" include Vehicle cabs, taxi cabs, cubicles and any areas up to 4 cubic meters

TERMINATOR Cleans, degreases and sanitises in one operation, Safe on paintwork, fabrics and hard surfaces. Effective against COVID-19. Kills 99.99% germs.
DIRECTIONS FOR USE:- Spray onto surface from around 20cm. Allow 30 seconds contact time to penetrate bacteria . Wipe away with a clean cloth or if possible leave to dry. For "the bomb" just press the nozzle into the lock position and walk away.
